

READ ALL INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY FROM START TO FINISH BEFORE BEGINNING INSTALLATION





- 1) \square Park vehicle on a level surface. Set the parking brake and chock wheels.
- 2) \square Raise the front of the vehicle and support the frame with jack stands. Remove the passenger side front wheel and set aside.
- 3) \square Loosen drag link rod end stud nut at steering knuckle using 21mm socket. Using ball joint puller, separate drag link rod end from steering knuckle. Remove nut and drag link from knuckle. See Illustration 1.
- 4) \square Mark where drag link enters adjusting sleeve. Measure distance between inner and outer drag link ball joints and record measurement below. See Illustration 2.


5) \square Loosen lower drag link adjusting sleeve clamp and un-screw drag link from adjusting sleeve.

- 6) \Box Thread new drag link into adjusting sleeve and adjust to length recorded in step 4. See Illustration 2, 3 and 4.
- 7) \Box Attach new drag link rod end to steering knuckle using new nut. Torque to 63 lb-ft. Torque adjusting sleeve clamp hardware to 26 lb-ft.
- 8) \square Install front wheels and lower vehicle to the ground. Tighten lug nuts to 80-110 lb-ft.
- 9) \square Center steering wheel and axle.

The steering wheel must be centered to ensure that the ESP system operates correctly.

To center the steering wheel, loosen both drag link adjustment sleeve clamp bolts and turn the drag link adjustment sleeve in desired direction. Adjustment sleeve bolts must face forward for good clearance. Torque clamp bolt bolts to 26 lb-ft.
