

## ROCK TOTAL - RS62116 Front Differential Glide Plate

Fits M210 (12 Bolt Dana 44) Front Axle 2021-2018 Jeep Wrangler JL Rubicon 2021 Jeep Gladiator JT Rubicon

- 1) Remove four bolts from the bottom of the front differential as shown in Illustration 1. Do not remove cover.
- 2) Loosely attach glide plate RS176910 to the differential cover with the supplied M8 bolts and washers using the two lower holes. See Illustration 2.
- 3) Place U-bolt RS740028 over the rear of the differential housing. See Illustration 3.
- 4) Loosely attach glide plate rear of differential housing with U-bolt and 5/16" hardware. U-bolt must be pushed forward against rib on top of differential housing.
- If U-bolt does not protrude enough, see procedure on back of instruction.
- 5) Install M8 bolts and washers through the two top holes of the glide plate into the diff housing.
- 6) Snug the lower then upper differential cover bolts.
- 7) Torque the four differential cover bolts to 25 lb-ft.
- 8) Torque 5/16" nuts to 15 lb-ft.
- 9) Inspect cover for fluid leaks periodically. If a leak is detected, remove and reseal cover per manufacturer's recommendations.



## If U-bolt does not protrude enough to install on glide plate:

- 1) Install nut on one end of U-bolt without washer.
- 2) Push down on other end, and up on glide plate and install other nut.
- 3) Install M8 bolts and washers through the two top holes of the glide plate into the diff housing.
- 4) Snug the lower then upper differential cover bolts.
- 5) Tighten u-bolt until thread come through nut.
- 6) Remove nuts one at a tiem and re-stall with washer.
- 7) Torque the four differential cover bolts to 25 lb-ft.
- 8) Torque 5/16" nuts to 15 lb-ft.
- 9) Inspect cover for fluid leaks periodically. If a leak is detected, remove and reseal cover per manufacturer's recommendations.
